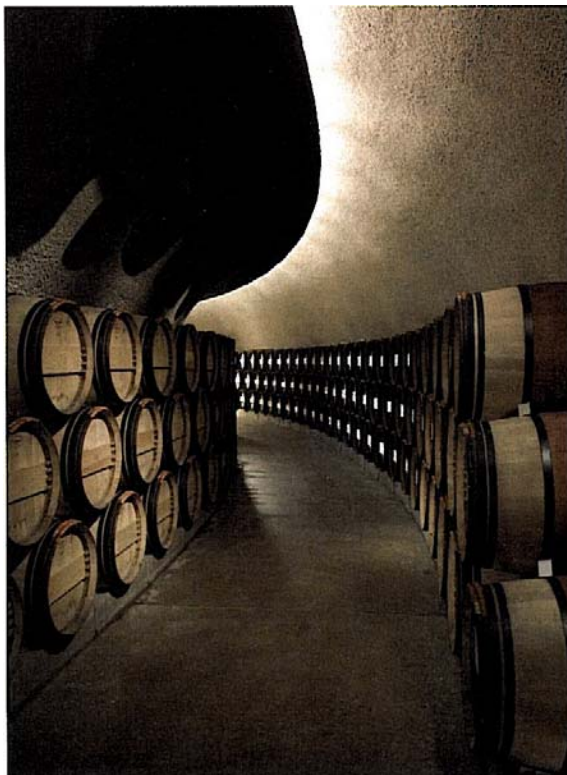

*It's all about green grapes at CADE Winery.*

CONSUMERS USED TO WALK INTO THE WINE RETAILER WITH JUST two words in mind: red or white? Now there is a new contender: green. As the number of people demanding organic/eco-conscious products grows, so, too, does the number of organic wines on lists and retail shelves. Officially opened last March, the solar-powered CADE, meaning "cask" or "barrel" in Shakespearean lingo, is the second winery in Napa to receive LEED certification. Architect Juan Carlos Fernandez of Lail Design Group designed the building with 30 percent fly-ash concrete, recycled steel, glass, and wood certified by the Forest Stewardship Council. A simple elevation — vertical concrete walls with an inverted floating roof — allow the rolling hills and towering manzanita trees to shine. 14,500 square feet of wine caves snake through the hillside in the shape of an inverted PlumpJack logo (a partner in CADE). The winery produces four scrumptious, organically grown wines: three Cabs and a Sauvignon Blanc.
